



Data Access

1. Data requirements for each research project are listed in Project Agreements.
2. Industry Partners who own the data and have signed the Project Agreement agree to provide the data to the project.
3. Methods of accessing data must be negotiated between the Chief Investigators and the Institutional Coordinator of each Industry Partner.
4. CEPS researchers must comply with each Industry Partner's legislative and policy requirements relating to research, and the provision of data.
5. Only CEPS researchers and students listed on the Project Agreement may access project data. Chief Investigators will notify the Institutional Coordinator of each Industry Partner of any changes in research staff, and seek the relevant approvals for new staff to access and handle project data.

Data Security

1. CEPS is subject to business, legislation and policy requirements relating to data access and security including the Australian Code for the Responsible Conduct of Research and the National Statement of Ethical Conduct in Research Involving Humans.
2. Chief Investigators are responsible for the security of data obtained for the purpose of conducting CEPS research.
3. Upon commencement of each research project, Chief Investigators will inform the Institutional Coordinator of each Industry Partner of the security measures in use at their research premises.
4. Chief Investigators will inform the Institutional Coordinator of each Industry Partner of any changes to these measures over the course of the research project.
